SUBJECT: **TIMELINE FOR THE SEARCH OF 2016 BRIGADA ESKWELA BEST IMPLEMENTER AWARDS**

DATE: May 6, 2016

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2008 re: Institutionalization of Brigada Eskwela Program or National Schools Maintenance Week (NSMW), and DepEd Memorandum No. 35, s. 2016 re: Implementing Brigada Eskwela 2016, this Division shall conduct a Search for recipient schools of 2016 Brigada Eskwela Best Implementer Awards with the theme: *Tayo Para sa Paaralang Ligtas, Maayos at Handa Mula Kindergarten, Hanggang Senior High School*”.

2. For effective implementation of Brigada Eskwela, School Heads are directed to follow the stipulations of Brigada Eskwela Manual for School Heads; DepEd Memorandum No. 35, s. 2016 re: Implementing Brigada Eskwela 2016; DepEd Order No. 2, s. 2013 re: Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act (RA) No. 8525 Otherwise known as the Adopt-A-School Program Act; and DepEd Order No. 32, s. 2014 re: Implementing Brigada Eskwela (Statement of Interest).

3. The Search for Brigada Eskwela Best Implementer shall be done based on the following timeline:

- a. May 30-June 4, 2016 – Monitoring on the conduct of 2016 Brigada Eskwela
- b. May 30, 2016 – Opening Program of Brigada Eskwela
- c. June 4, 2016 – Closing Program of Brigada Eskwela
- d. June 18, 2016 – Submission of School’s 2016 Brigada Eskwela Reports
- e. June 20, 2016 – Submission of Letter of Intent signifying the intention to join in the search. The letter of Intent shall be addressed to the Schools Division Superintendent and signed by the Brigada Eskwela Coordinator and School Head and endorsed by the District Supervisor.

- f. June 21-23, 2016 – Validation and selection of the recipients of Brigada Eskwela Best Implementer Awards
- g. June 27, 2016 – Announcement of the Winners of the Search for Brigada Eskwela Best Implementer Awards.

4. Expenses incurred in the Search for 2016 Brigada Eskwela Best Implementer shall be charged to Adopt-A-School Program (ASP) funds and local school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

For effective implementation of Brigada Eskwela, School Heads are directed to inform the populations of Brigada Eskwela through School Heads, DepEd Memorandum No. 55, s. 2014 re: Implementing Brigada Eskwela 2016, DepEd Order No. 2, s. 2015 re: Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act (RA) No. 8225 (otherwise known as the Adopt-A-School Program Act), and DepEd Order No. 32, s. 2014 re: Implementing DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2008 (Department of Interest).

- e. June 23, 2016 – Submission of Letter of Intent signifying the intention to join in the search. The letter of intent shall be addressed to the Schools Division Superintendent and signed by the Brigada Eskwela Coordinator and School Head and order sent by the District Supervisor.
